Summary Minutes of the meeting.

The minutes were agreed subject to actions to be completed on page 3 of the 15th June mins.

Finance:

Spread sheets for the periods were distributed and discussed; conclusion was that SBL had not spent a great deal of money this period, some £14.5k to the end of May 16. AVA has requested their consultation fees etc.

A further £500 is marked for the cubs grant. It was said that monies not drawn down from the lottery would at least be earning interest.

Youth Worker:

Colin handed out an A4 hand written document and walked the meeting through the various points; Colin needs to raise an invoice for the balance of the monies granted. It was agreed that a continuation with “the drop” on Tuesday evening would go ahead, however a new female youth worker was required, advertisements have been done and it was agreed that only having a 1 year contract was a limiting factor in the recruitment process, therefore it was agreed that it would be a two year contract along with the funding. A vote was cast (Colin Frampton did not vote due to a conflict of loyalty) the vote was unanimous to carry on.

Football Club & SRG

The proposal for the Joint Venture with the two clubs SFC & LR dates need to be agreed for the review meeting, once reviewed and agreed it then needs to be put in front of ACC. Hopefully a review meeting can take place in week 29

Any Other Business:

De-Fib up date to site an old telephone box would cost in excess of £1500 plus installation etc. It was agreed that Trevor would look at other options. The roll out of the training has gone very well with schools etc getting involved.

The football kits for the school had been ordered:

- 2 complete kits with logos

- 20 training bibs
- 10 footballs
- 10 or 20 coloured training cones

All the above for £792.00 well done Emma for finding the supplier.
